Communication and Language

 There will be lots of opportunities for conversations with familiar adults and friends, developing the children's range of vocabulary and the ability to turn take in those conversations.

Literacy

- We will continue to learn a new rhyme each week, linked to our topic.
- We will listen to lots of stories and talk about what has happened, encouraging the children to pose their own 'why' questions about the text.
- We will continue with our dough disco and crayon dancing sessions to help with our early writing skills.

Understanding the World

- We will be exploring all things autumnal, using all of our senses, talking together about what we have discovered.
- We will be talking about differences and changes in materials, when we are carrying out activities such as cooking festive biscuits.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will begin to remember the rules of the classroom without needing an adult to remind us of them.
- We will be joining the rest of the school at Liturgical Prayer and assemblies, becoming more outgoing with unfamiliar people, showing more confidence in different situations.

- We will talk about belonging to God's family and how we are welcomed into the Church when we are Baptised.
