

Year 1 – Summer 2



Phonics

The children will be learning their set 1, 2 and 3 sounds. We follow the Read Write Inc scheme and the children will identify special friends in their words when reading. The children will blend sounds together to form words and can identify a range of red words (words that are not phonetically decodable). Children will also undertake their phonics screening test, which the government require the children to take to discover how many real and 'alien' words the children can decipher. <https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/reading-schemes-oxford-levels/read-write-inc-phonics-guide/>

Science

This half term in science our topic is plants. We will be finding out the names of the different parts of plants as well as having a go at growing some of our own. We will be able to name lots of common wild and garden plants.

Computers

Using their curriculum topic as inspiration, children should be able to type letters on Microsoft Word. They should develop their mouse skills to draw more detailed images on paint software. As well as this, the children will always revisit their E-safety rules to recall how to stay safe when using the suite.

Mastering Number

Children will continue to revise their numbers to 20 to see how our teen numbers are made. We will partition these numbers to develop our number sense of tens and ones.

RE

Being sorry – During this topic, the children will look at right and wrong choices and discover that we can be forgiven for making bad choices if we apologise.

Neighbours – During this Cafod topic, the children will look at sharing God's word with our neighbours around the world.

PHSE/RSE

Three in one – We will look at the Holy Trinity and what it means for us.

Communities- The children will look at being part of a community and the responsibilities that come with that.

At Home

The children's reading books are changed every Tuesday and they will keep this book for the week. They need to bring this into school every day, as there are always reading opportunities throughout the day. Homework goes home every Friday and is due back into school on a Wednesday. This always corresponds to the maths or grammar work that we have completed during the week

Maths

Fractions- We will discover what one half and one quarter is and split objects or amounts into groups of 2 or 4.

Place Value (Within 100)- Building on our prior learning of place value, we will partition numbers into 10s and 1s and compare numbers between 50 and 100.

Measurement (Money)- Recognise coins and notes.

Measurement (Time)- Discover hours, minutes and seconds

PE

Athletics – We will be learning to move at different speeds over varying distances, develop our balance, develop agility and co-ordination, explore hopping, jumping and leaping for distance. We will also develop our throwing for distance and accuracy.

History

We will be looking at events, people and places in the local area to discover who Grace Darling was and what made her so special.

Design & Technology

The children will be making their own fruit and vegetable salad plate. They will develop their chopping skills to chop their chosen food before designing their own face.

Music

During summer term 2, we will be reviewing the different skills we have been learning in music sessions this year. We will sing and play ukuleles.
