Phonics and English

Phonics - We continue our work in our phonics groups. Each group will cover a range of fun reading and writing activities matched to their ability.

Language and Literacy – For children who have now completed the phonics scheme, we are focusing on writing. We are including description, varying how our sentences start and self-editing work.

Guided reading - We continue to enjoy our group reading sessions. We are working on predicting what might happen next, being able to find answers in the text as well as thinking about why characters might behave in certain ways.

Science

This half term in science our topic is plants. We will be finding out what plants need to grow and stay healthy, and that plants grow from seeds and bulbs. We will even have a go at growing some of our own.

Computers

This half term, we will be completing our coding topic using Scratch and Turtle, incorporating sound into our instructions (algorithms). We will then create simple animations. We will also be using the computers to input data and create charts for our work in mathematics.
