## Communication and Language

- We will talk about different forms of transport, name and label their different parts.
- Based on the story, 'We're going on a bear hunt,'
  we will reinvent the story, 'we're going on a beach
  hunt,' and make our own beach area.
- We will explore places to visit from brochures and talk about our journey to the destinations.

#### Literacy

- Following our Read Write Inc scheme, we will continue learning Set I and some Set 2 sounds.
- We will begin to learn some red words e.g. I, the, my.
- We will be reading our sound blending books.
- In class we will be doing guided reading, where we read short stories using all of the sounds and red words that we know.
- We will answer some questions about the stories we have read and listened to.

# Understanding the World

- We will start our 'Transport and Journeys' topic where we will explore different forms of transport and different journeys we go on.
- We will look a variety of transport from the past and present and say how they are similar and different.
- We will explore friction by investigating different materials on a ramp to see which makes the vehicle travel the furthest.

# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- In our outdoor space, we will set up a car-wash with buckets and soapy water and encourage the children to work together to clean the large wheeled toys.
- We will learn about road safety, talking about the green cross code; how to keep ourselves safe around the road and vehicles
- We will follow the 'Ten-Ten' programme and learn about looking after our bodies, growing up and what we want to be when

## Physical Development

## We will have PE on a Tuesday—PE kit needed for each lesson.
