<u>Staffing</u>

<u>Curriculum</u>

This week the children have been spending time getting to know their class staff and routines.

The next few weeks art and history will be the focus of our topic work.

<u>Journals</u>

Next week, your child will receive a copy of their school journal with their reading book. The home-school agreement is an important document within the journal and needs to be signed by your child, their teacher and you, as their parent. Please ensure that you discuss this with your child and sign the document as it contains lots of important information, including our school rules.

The uniform policy, **including the wearing of jewellery**, is also in the journal, so please see this for guidance, as we have noticed children returning to school with jewellery or items of clothing which are not in line with our policy.

<u>Clubs</u>

Breakfast and after school clubs are available for children from Reception to Year 6. These sessions, each costing £2.00, must be booked in advance. Children can be dropped off at the office, no earlier than 8.00am and no later than 8:15am and children attending all after school clubs must be collected from the office at 4:15pm.

This year there will also be a £2.00 charge for other extra-curricular clubs such as football and basketball. Please see the attached clubs timetable which will recommence next week. Please return the slip if you wish for your child to be added to the club register.

Healthy Eating

As we promote healthy eating in our school, can you please ensure that if your child wishes to have a breaktime snack, that only fruit or vegetables are brought in. Early Years and Key Stage 1 children are provided with a school snack.

Our lunch menu is available from the school office, should you wish to collect a copy and discuss it with your child. If your child has a packed lunch, we would encourage you to limit the amount of sugary treats. Please remember that fizzy drinks are not permitted.

<u>Birthdays</u>

Children who have their birthdays in term-time, enjoy celebrating them in school with their friends. However, can we please ask that you do not send large birthday cakes that requiring cutting into school, as we have limited time and we must be mindful of those children with dietary requirements. You may wish to send in a small, individually wrapped treat which can be sent home with children at the end of the day.

Photographers are expected to be in school on **Monday 30th September** from 8:30am to take class and individual photographs.

Flu immunisations are due to be given on the **2nd October**. Parents will have received an email this week with further information. No child will be given this immunisation without parental consent. Below is the link and school number.
